Explanation

There is a decrease in the average fuel costs for electricity production combined with a decrease in the correction factor regarding February 2025, resulting in decreased electricity tariffs. The slight increase in the water tariffs is the result of lower electricity costs for the production of water and a higher correction factor regarding February 2025.
