Explanation

There is a slight decrease in the average fuel costs for electricity production combined with an increase in the correction factor regarding April 2025, resulting in a minor increase in the electricity tariffs. The decrease in the water tariffs is the result of lower electricity costs for the production of water and a lower correction factor regarding April 2025.
