Explanation

There is a minor decrease in the average fuel costs for electricity production combined with an increase in the correction factor regarding August 2025, resulting in a minimal increase of the electricity tariffs. The slight increase in the water tariffs is the result of higher electricity costs for the production of water and a lower correction factor regarding August 2025.
