Explanation

There is a decrease in the average fuel costs for electricity production combined with a decrease in the correction factor regarding September 2025, resulting in a decrease in the electricity tariffs. The decrease in the water tariffs is the result of higher electricity costs for the production of water and a lower correction factor regarding September 2025.
