Explanation

There is a decrease in the average fuel costs for electricity production combined with an increase in the correction factor for the month of October 2025, resulting in a decrease in the electricity tariffs. The decrease in the water tariffs is the result of lower electricity costs for the production of water and a lower correction factor for the month of October 2025.
