Explanation

There is a slight decrease in the average fuel costs for electricity production, combined with a slight increase in the correction factor for the month of December 2025, resulting in a slight increase in the electricity tariffs. The increase in the water tariffs results from a modest decrease in electricity costs to produce water and a higher correction factor for the month of December 2025.
