**Explanation**

There is a slight increase in the average fuel costs for electricity production, combined with a decrease in the correction factor for the month of March 2026, resulting in a slight decrease in the electricity tariffs. The increase in the water tariffs results from a decrease in electricity costs to produce water and a higher correction factor for the month of March 2026.
