Explanation

There is a decrease in the average fuel costs for electricity production, combined with an increase in the correction factor for the month of April 2026, resulting in an increase in the electricity tariffs. The slight decrease in the water tariffs results from a decrease in electricity costs to produce water and a higher correction factor for the month of April 2026.
