Explanation

There is a slight decrease in the average fuel costs for electricity production, combined with an increase in the correction factor for the month of June 2026, resulting in higher electricity tariffs. The decrease in the water tariffs results from lower electricity costs for water production and a higher correction factor for the month of June 2026.
