Explanation

There is an increase in the average fuel costs for electricity production, combined with a slight increase in the correction factor for the month of July 2026, resulting in higher electricity tariffs. The decrease in the water tariffs results from higher electricity costs for water production and a lower correction factor for the month of July 2026.
